School Census Day – Change to Dinner Menu

Thursday 4th October is School Census Day and we would like to encourage all of our children to have a school dinner on this day. Helena will be offering Friday's menu choice of fish fingers and chips on this day, so Thursday and Friday will simply swap days. The October School Census is used to determine our allocation of funds for 2018/19 from Devon County Council and school dinner uptake is a major indicator for these funds. If we can encourage as many of our pupils as possible to have a school dinner on this day this will impact our schools financial position and ultimately benefit our pupils. Our school funding is also greatly influenced by the number of pupils eligible for Free School Meals. This is a separate funding pot from the Universal Infant Free Meals that pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive. Free School Meals (FSM) generate Pupil Premium income which is used to support those families who are eligible, or have been eligible at any time in the past 6 years. Families eligible for FSM can apply on-line through the Devon County Council free school meal website: <https://new.devon.gov.uk/educationandfamilies/school-information/school-meals> or by telephone on 0345 1551019. Please consider applying for FSM if you believe you may be entitled as it really does make a difference to our school, thank you.
