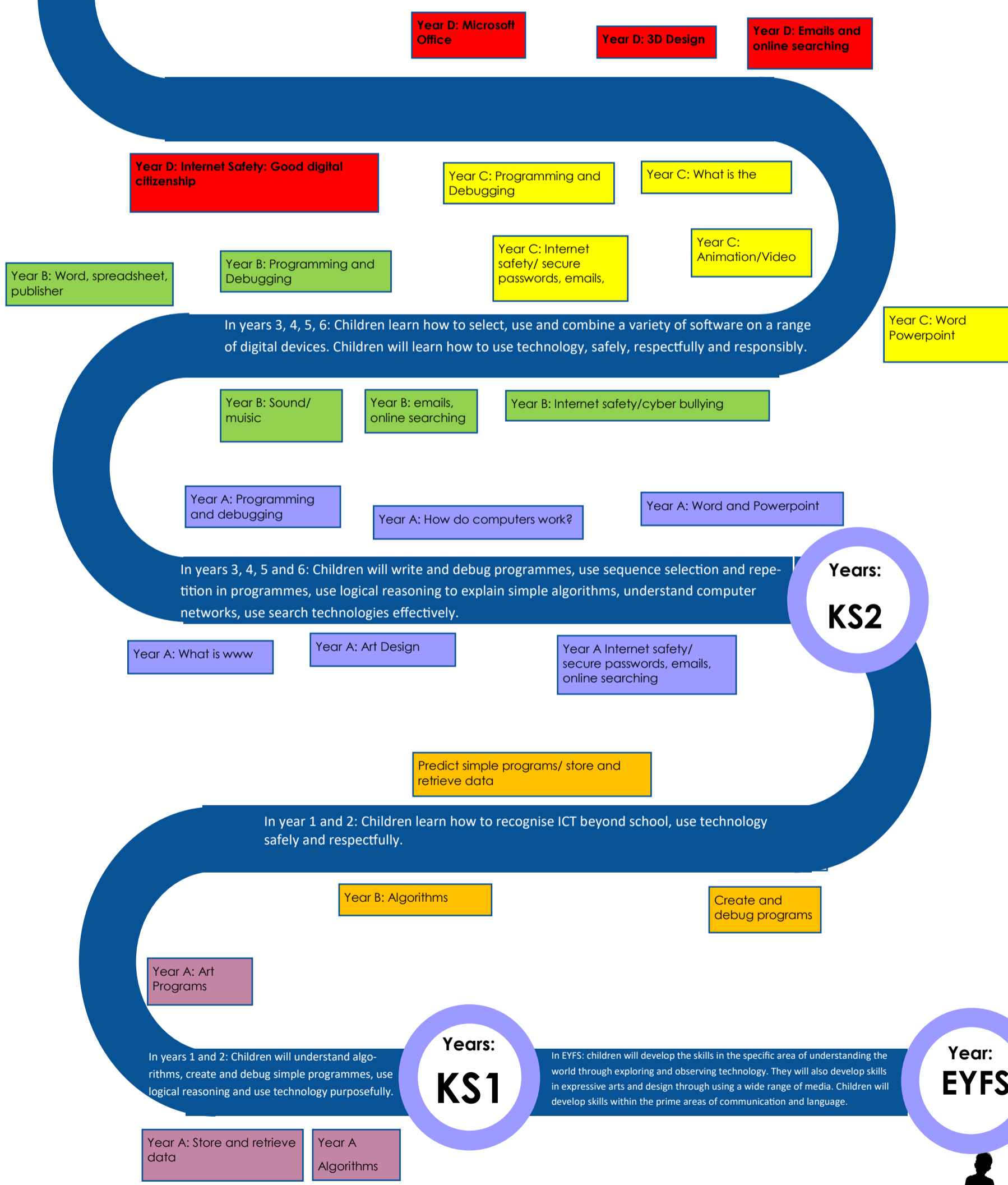


Chittlehampton C of E Primary COMPUTING LEARNING JOURNEY



TRANSITION TO SECONDARY



In years 3, 4, 5, 6: Children learn how to select, use and combine a variety of software on a range of digital devices. Children will learn how to use technology, safely, respectfully and responsibly.

In years 3, 4, 5 and 6: Children will write and debug programmes, use sequence selection and repetition in programmes, use logical reasoning to explain simple algorithms, understand computer networks, use search technologies effectively.

Years: KS2

In year 1 and 2: Children learn how to recognise ICT beyond school, use technology safely and respectfully.

In years 1 and 2: Children will understand algorithms, create and debug simple programmes, use logical reasoning and use technology purposefully.

Years: KS1

In EYFS: children will develop the skills in the specific area of understanding the world through exploring and observing technology. They will also develop skills in expressive arts and design through using a wide range of media. Children will develop skills within the prime areas of communication and language.
